## RESOLUTION NO. 5011

REALLOCATE FUNDING FROM FOUR ELECTRICAL MAINTENANCE TECHNICIAN POSITIONS IN ORDER TO FUND TWO NEW METER TECHNICIAN POSITIONS AND TWO NEW SUBSTATION TECHNICIAN POSITIONS; AND RECOMMEND CITY COUNCIL ESTABLISH THE CLASSIFICATIONS OF METER TECHNICIAN AND SUBSTATION TECHNICIAN AND ADD TWO NEW METER TECHNICIAN POSITIONS AND TWO SUBSTATION TECHNICIAN POSITIONS; AND AMEND THE SALARY SCHEDULE OF THE INTERNATIONAL BROTHERHOOD OF ELECTRICAL WORKERS (IBEW)

WHEREAS, in order to provide a workforce that is appropriately allocated, classified and compensated at Alameda Municipal Power, the following workforce changes are proposed; and

WHEREAS, the Board has been briefed and approves reallocation of funds of four Electrical Maintenance Technician positions for the two Meter Technician positions and two Substation Technicians position; and

WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council add the following positions; two Meter Technicians and two Substation Technicians; and

WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council delete the following positions; four Electrical Maintenance Technicians; and

WHEREAS, the Board recommends that the City Council amend the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers salary schedule to include Meter Technician and Substation Technician effective March 19, 2017; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Public Utilities Board of the City of Alameda hereby recommends the City Council to implement the workforce and funding changes as described.

THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provision of this Resolution shall supersede any other resolution in conflict herewith.
