Proclamation

Whereas, the Sister City program provides opportunities for cultural exchanges and creating bonds between people from different cities around the world, which enriches ourselves and broadens our understanding of the world and our place in it; and

Whereas, the cities of Alameda in the United States and Yeongdong-gun County of Chungcheongbuk-do Province in South Korea share a common Sister City in Dumaguete in the Philippines; and

Whereas, representatives from Alameda and Yeongdong-gun met in November 2015, during a visit to Dumaguete under the auspices of Sister Cities International; and

Whereas, both Alameda and Yeongdong-gun have a tremendous opportunity, first, to learn from one another about how to improve our communities and, second, to create better cross-cultural and international understanding by getting to know one another through person-to-person relationships.

Now, therefore be it resolved, that I, Trish Herrera Spencer, Mayor of the City of Alameda, do hereby proclaim that Alameda will endeavor to improve its friendly relationship with Yeongdong-gun through active communication on shared interests, based on mutual trust and respect for the historical and cultural traditions of both regions.
