- Announcements/Public Comments
 - Robert Briscoe Can the new Line 96 serve the Main Street Ferry Terminal?
 - Maria Gallo Traffic is getting worse on Marina Drive with more housing. In addition, the ILC meetings need to be better publicized.
- AC Transit Ridership Trend
 - Can staff analyze the causes for ridership decreases?
 - Some buses are overcrowded while some are empty
 - What can be done on the 51A to alleviate bunching and overcrowding?
 - Can we explore a limited-stop service on Line 51A
 - Is Line 21 timed properly with the Harbor Bay Ferry service?
 - We should promote the Line 21 as the shuttle between the Harbor Bay Ferry and the satellite parking at Island Drive
- WETA/AC Transit Fare Reimbursement MOU
 - MOU is no longer necessary. The free transfer between WETA and AC Transit was implemented on Clipper on 3/15/17
- Easypass Update: Northern Waterfront and Alameda Point Collaborative
 - Alameda Collaborative now has buses free to its residents
 - In the Lennar project, 47 of the 96 units have Easy Pass
 - Staff will work on a joint press release for this effort
 - John Atkinson asked if there is a program to make EasyPass less restrictive and made available to individual property owners. This is included in the City's transit plan recommendations
- Northern Waterfront Line 19 Update/Oakland Terminus
 - The change in the end of line in Downtown Oakland needs to be communicated to riders and potential riders along the 19 corridor
 - The schedule has too much time resulting in early arrivals and departures from timepoints. AC Transit has adjusted the schedule to be more reliable
 - CM Mattarese has noticed more people waiting for the bus along Buena Vista
 - CM Mattarese asked to fix the stop at Atlantic & Webster in front of the Starbucks
 - \circ The planter strip needs to be filled-in in order to make the stop accessible
 - The Estuary Shuttle will be ending in June, hopefully shifting more riders to the 19
 - The 19 is equipped with 3-position bike racks
- West End Line 31/Line 96 Modification Update

- CM Ashcraft wants to see an interim or permanent solution sooner to serve the Main Street Ferry Terminal.
- Evaluate the Line 21 issues to improve connection with Harbor Bay Ferry
- Alameda County Transportation Commission 2018 CIP Results
 - Alameda received \$35 million, which is second highest to Oakland
 - Projects include:
 - 1. Clement extension with bus-only lanes to the bridge
 - 2. Seaplane Lagoon
 - 3. Alameda Point RAMP improvements
- New Developments Update
 - AC Transit and the City of Alameda need to develop an MOU for the funding of new service to Alameda Point
- Other Items
 - CM Ashcraft asked about the feasibility of an island circular shuttle and a funding plan for it. Should the shuttle incorporate driverless technology?
 - Invite Tony Kutner to the next meeting to discuss
 - CM Mattarese asked to extend meeting to 90 minutes or longer in order to have in-depth discussions on key agenda items
 - Staff should plan on presentation or accomplishments for a larger community meeting in the future
