Background

- 6/6/17 Council approved Water Infrastructure Agreement for Alameda Point with EBMUD
 - City required to connect service to parcels and facilitate owners and tenants becoming EBMUD customers
 - EBMUD will give City a \$19.5M and \$7M credit for System Capacity Charges (SCC) and Wastewater Capacity Charges (WCF) to offset fees of existing and future tenants
