

- Package of more than 12 bills to address California's housing crisis were passed
- Bills await Governor Brown's signature
- Governor expected to sign at least three major bills



## • SB2: The Permanent Source

- \$75 filing fee on real estate transactions (deeds, notices, refinancing not home sales)
- Raises \$250 million/year
- Beginning in 2019, 70% of funds directly allocated to local governments
- City of Alameda supported this bill

## SB3: \$4 Billion Housing Bond

- Goes to voters in November 2018
- \$1.5B for affordable housing development
- City of Alameda supported this bill

## • SB35: Streamlined Approval Process

- streamlines approval process for certain housing developments in areas that have not created enough new housing to meet the region's needs
- City of Alameda opposed this bill
