

REGISTRAR OF VOTERS CERTIFICATE TO PETITION

I, **Tim Dupuis**, Registrar of Voters for the County of Alameda, State of California, hereby certify that:
An Initiative Petition titled: A Proposed City of Alameda Charter Amendment Making the "City of Alameda Rent Review, Rent Stabilization and Limitations on Evictions Ordinance" a Part of the Alameda City Charter, was filed with the Alameda City Clerk within the statutory time limit and forwarded to this office for verification on September 5, 2017 and;

The petition contained 10,280 unverified signatures; and

Pursuant to California Elections Code section 9215, in order to be sufficient, the petition must have been signed by 7,211 qualified registered voters in the City of Alameda, with the most recent report of **48,074** registered voters in the City and;

I have examined, or caused to be examined, signatures on the petition pursuant to California Elections Code sections 9211 and 9115; and

Have determined that the petition contained 435 valid signatures of qualified registered voters in the City of Alameda based on the random sample examination set forth in section 9115 and the formula prescribed by the California Secretary of State; and

That this number represents 124.03% of the total number of signatures needed to qualify the initiative; therefore

The petition is found to be sufficient to require the City Council of the City of Alameda to take the appropriate action specified in the California Elections Code.
