



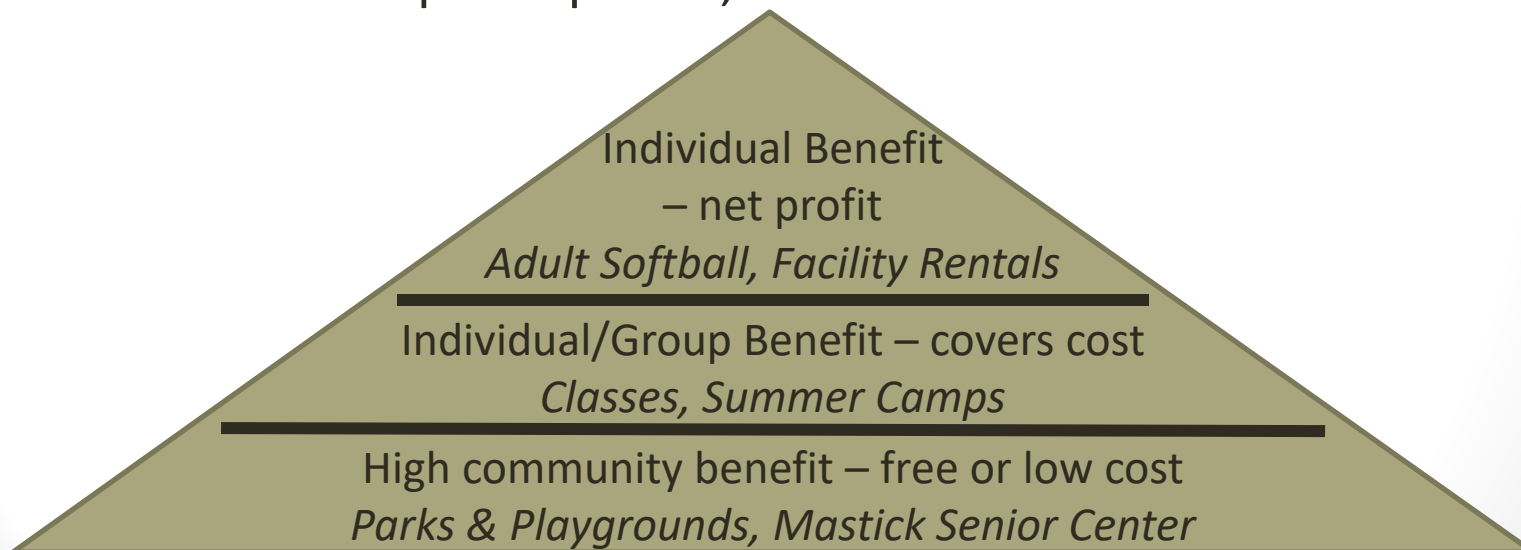
# 2018 Recreation and Park User Fee Schedule

# Background

- High level challenges that impact fees:
  - California State Minimum Wage increasing annually up to \$15/hr in 2022.
  - Increasing health and PERS costs
- Balance of market demand and covering costs = incremental fee increases.
- Fees include direct costs (staff, facilities, supplies) plus indirect costs (administrative staff and supplies)
- Reviewed fee comparisons and balanced with unique aspects of Alameda.
- Ensured that non-Alameda is 15% - 20% higher than resident/Alameda organizations

# ARPD Cost Recovery Model

- Goal to provide more effective cost recovery balanced with community benefit.
- Improved cost recovery primarily due to reduced expenses and increased participation, with minimal fee increases.



# Revised Fees for 2018

Practices	\$115/hr (remains same)
League Games and Tournaments	\$125/hr
Youth & Aquatic Program Fees	3% Increase

Portable Toilet Fee	At cost + admin fee
Krusi and Lincoln Rec Center Rental	\$120/hr Resident \$160/hr Non-Res
Admin Fee for Revising Rental Permits	\$25
Summer Bus Rental	At cost + \$3.50/mi + \$20/hr

Program Transportation Fee	At cost from vendor
