GIG Car Share celebrated its inaugural launch in Berkeley and Oakland on April 30, 2017. Unlike other Bay Area car share services, Gig offers one-way, or point-to-point service that allows people to pick up a car in one location and drop it off in another – no need to return it to the same spot. You just find a nearby car, get in and go!

Quick Facts

Vehicles: A brand-new fleet of 500 sleek, black, hybrid-electric cars complete with a bicycle roof rack.

Member Cost: Structured for maximum flexibility, there is no signup or annual fee, so you only pay for what you use. \$2.50 a mile for short trips, \$15 an hour, or \$85 for the day – whatever is cheapest.

Location: Use the Gig app to find the car closest to you. Right now, you can find Gigs in much of Berkeley and Oakland.

Parking: Thanks to agreements with our city partners, members park for free almost anywhere in the Berkeley and Oakland "HomeZone" including two-hour or more public, metered, and residential permit spaces. There are also dedicated parking spaces at key transportation connectors like BART stations and the Oakland International Airport.

Register: It's easy. Download the app, scan your driver's license, enter your info, and start driving.

Why one-way car share?

- One-way car sharing offers flexibility; mandatory round-trips to the original starting point is not required.
- Car ownership is expensive, costing the typical American \$8,000 per year. Gig membership covers the cost of maintenance, insurance, fuel, and parking in the HomeZone.
- Car share reduces traffic congestion. Every Gig vehicle takes seven-to-eleven cars off the road, providing a substitute for private vehicles and ride-hailing services, complementing public transit, and improving quality of life. Research shows significant reductions in vehicle purchases and miles traveled when compared with personal auto use in cities where one-way car share is already available.
- One-way car share expands transit options and fills in the gap, providing relief in transit deserts, offering availability 24 hours a day, and delivering a new mobility option for underserved populations.
- It's good for the environment. Every car share vehicle eliminates four to seven metric tons of greenhouse gas emissions each year. Gig's 100% hybrid-electric fleet goes a step further in replacing less efficient vehicles.
