2019 Recreation and Park User Fee Schedule

Background

- High level challenges that impact fees:
 - Alameda Minimum Wage increasing to \$13.50/hour on July 1, 2019 and then to \$15.00/hour on July 1, 2020.
 - Increasing health and PERS costs and facility costs for utilities.
- Balance of market demand and covering costs = incremental fee increases.
- Fees include direct costs (staff, facilities, supplies) plus indirect costs (administrative staff and supplies)
- Reviewed fee comparisons and balanced with unique aspects of Alameda.
- Ensured that non-Alameda is 15% 20% higher than resident/Alameda organizations

ARPD Cost Recovery Model

- Goal to provide more effective cost recovery balanced with community benefit.
- Improved cost recovery primarily due to reduced expenses and increased participation, with minimal fee increases.

Individual/Group Benefit – covers cost Classes, Summer Camps

High community benefit – free or low cost Parks & Playgrounds, Mastick Senior Center
