DECLARING NOVEMBER 11-17 UNITED AGAINST HATE WEEK IN THE CITY OF ALAMEDA, IN CONJUNCTION WITH THE ALAMEDA UNIFIED SCHOOL BOARD AND OTHER BAY AREA CITIES

WHEREAS, the City Council strengthened this stand when it voted to reaffirm the City of Alameda's commitment as a Sanctuary City to the values of dignity, inclusivity, and respect for all individuals, regardless of ethnic or national origin, gender, race, religious affiliation, sexual orientation, or immigration status; and

WHEREAS, education, compassion, and cooperation are key to understanding and embracing differences between people; and

WHEREAS, sponsoring a United Against Hate Week is an important step in bridging divisions and healing communities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Alameda, that Alameda stands together with other Bay Area Communities and hereby declares the week of November 11-18 2018, as United Against Hate Week in Alameda.
