Transportation Choices Plan Annual Report

- Ortiz Was not aware that the goal was to get Alameda Point residents to Bart
 - o Thomas yes, get riders to Bart
- Peeples Not enough capacity at 12th Street Bart to take on more users from Alameda Point
 - o Del Rosario Staff looking at all modes
 - o Daysog Line W used to travel through the west end of Alameda
- Bus service to ferry
 - o Ortiz Big issue is free parking at the ferry, which would prevent people from taking the
- Easy Pass
 - o AC Transit/Alameda partnership will become a model for other cities and developments to follow
- Daysog AC Transit's patience with the city to come along during AC Go was great
- Ortiz Bus shelters
 - o Payne will replace six shelters in the next year
- Ortiz Transportation awareness focuses on marketing services that Alamedans are not aware
 of
 - o Payne There is a transportation awareness advisory group assembled on the City's side
- Peeples TFCA funding for transportation awareness
 - o Knox White decrease of 14% of single auto trips
- Knox White EasyPass expansion hasn't been happening rollover needs to be
- Ortiz need to be nimble and enter into agreements for Easy pass quickly

Alameda Point Development

- Kuttner Saratoga/Monarch loop Why route service up to W. Midway Ave?
 - Berman To serve the affordable housing at W. Midway and Pan Am (Alameda Point Collaborative)
- Knox White What is the timing of a route change?
- Knox White What is the current ridership of the line?
- Knox White We shouldn't plan for routes on streets that may be configured under development of Site B
 - o Thomas roads could be a mess south of west Atlantic
- Knox White Service between Seaplane Lagoon and Spirits Alley could be useful however
- Daysog if routing went down to Santa Clara, it would get more riders to the ferry
- Public comment Most riders would be coming from Alameda's south side would be served by a route from South Shore and Encinal

- Knox White West Atlantic needs to be served under this plan.
- Berman No bus turnaround at Seaplane is planned in initial phasing.

Ridership and Customer Comments

- Kuttner why is ridership decreasing?
 - o Del Rosario explained that national and local trends show a growing share of trips taken on rideshare, increasing car ownership rates, etc.
- Public How can we promote the line 19 if there are no shows?
 - o Ortiz Not enough operators need to have better reliability
 - o Llamas Discussed initiatives to improve recruitment and reliability
- Peeples advocating scheduling service based on operator availability
- Ortiz Realigning the Operations Control Center to better monitor routes and service
 - o Llamas Will focus on areas and routes
 - o Peeples Records from a similar effort from the 90s at AC Transit
- Public Need to prioritize correctly the reduction of service to match the operator count
 - o Del Rosario agrees, we want to have the least impact on riders

- Kuttner Are you double counting hours to Bart and within alameda?
 - o Berman No, those are separated deliberately.

RM3/Transbay Tomorrow

 - o Ortiz This is a policy decision.
- Knox White Can Transbay Tomorrow include unfunded needs as well?
 - o Eshleman Yes.

 - o Del Rosario Still on scheduled information but better information to the supervisors to convey to the riders
