This email is to contribute my thoughts on the Rent Control Issue. I favor Open Government and Sunshine Ordinances.

What I read about Just Cause Eviction bills is an injustice. We must have equal treatment under the law. The same rules must apply to everyone. If a Tenant can leave for any or no reason a Landlord should be able to take back their own property for any or no reason. People do want housing, but it is not a right under the Constitution which is protected as being able to be enforced upon others.
