

FIRST AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This Amendment of the Agreement, entered into this 7th day of February, 2019, by and between the CITY OF ALAMEDA, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and TETRA TECH, INC., a Delaware corporation, whose address is 1999 Harrison Street, Suite 500 Oakland, CA 94612-3599, (hereinafter "Provider"), is made with reference to the following:

RECITALS:

- A. On April 16th, 2018, an agreement was entered into by and between City and Tetra Tech, Inc. (hereinafter "Agreement").
- B. City and Provider desire to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the undersigned parties as follows:

1. Item No. 1 **TERM** of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"The term of this First Amendment to Agreement shall commence on the 1st day of March 2019, and shall terminate on the 1st day of March 2020, unless terminated earlier as set forth herein."

2. Item No. 2 <u>SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED</u> of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"Provider agrees to do all necessary work at its own cost and expense, to furnish all labor, tools, equipment, materials, except as otherwise specified, and to do all necessary work included in Exhibit A1 as requested. The Provider acknowledges that the work plan included in Exhibit A1 is tentative and does not commit the City to request Provider to perform all tasks included therein."

3. Item No. 3 <u>COMPENSATION TO PROVIDER</u> of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"By the 7th day of each month, Provider shall submit to the City an invoice for the total amount of work done the previous month. Pricing and accounting of charges are to be according to the fee schedule as set forth in <u>Exhibit B1</u> and incorporated herein by this reference. Payment will be made in the same manner that claims of a like character are paid by the City, with checks drawn on the treasury of said City, to be taken from CIP 91402. Extra work must be approved in writing by the City Manager or his/her designee prior to performance and shall be paid on a Time and Material basis as set forth in Exhibit B1.

- a. The total compensation for the work under this First Amendment to Agreement is not to exceed \$25,728, which includes a 5% contingency, for a total agreement amount of \$72,351.65.
- 4. Except as expressly modified herein, all other terms and covenants set forth in the Agreement shall remain the same and shall be in full force and effect.

Subject: Proposal for Continued Construction Phase Engineering Remedial Support for the Cross Alameda Trail, Alameda, CA (CIP No.: 91402)

Tetra Tech is pleased to submit this proposal for continued engineering work prior to and during remediation at the Cross Alameda Trail property located between Webster Street and Main Street, along the south side of Ralph Appezzato Memorial Parkway (hereinafter referred to as the site), in Alameda, California. Under contract to the City of Alameda, Department of Public Works (City), Tetra Tech has done previous engineering construction support work, remedial reports, investigations, a risk assessment, and a Remedial Action Plan. The scope of work presented as a part of this proposal includes continued engineering construction support work (analysis of borrow source data and information and once construction begins, limited oversight of construction activities).

This proposal is being submitted at the request of Mr. Jack Dybas, Architect and Project Manager, Public Works, for approval under the Tetra Tech agreement for on-call environmental services with the City of Alameda, dated February 1, 2018.

TASK 1 EVALUATION OF BORROW SOURCE DATA AND INFORMATION

Tetra Tech will continue to assist the City in evaluation of data from others on whether proposed borrow source material would be suitable for import to the Project. This includes reviewing geotechnical reports, environmental reports, and other information provided. Tetra Tech will participate in meetings and discussions with contractors, the City, and regulatory agencies to evaluate the properties of the borrow material. The results of our evaluations and our professional opinions will be provided in phone calls and in emails to the City.

TASK 2 REMEDIAL CONSTRUCTION OVERSIGHT

Tetra Tech will provide engineering oversight of construction activities during the remediation portion of site construction. This will include attendance and participation in site meetings with the City and construction crews, periodic field documentation of construction remedial activities, and documentation of compliance with remedial plans and specifications. Preparation of a remediation report of compliance is scoped and funded under our prior agreement dated February 1, 2018.

Assumptions (Task 2)

The duration of construction is 26 weeks. Our oversight activities will be for approximately 10 hours per week for 8 of the 26 weeks.

FEE PROPOSAL

Tetra Tech proposes to provide the services described in this proposal on a Time and Materials/Not to Exceed (T&M/NTE) basis for a total fee of \$25,728. Please note this is a time and materials estimate and that our invoices will reflect only the necessary effort estimated to complete the desired services. Our fee estimate is based on the assumptions presented under the Scope of Work for this proposal. A breakdown of costs by task is provided in Table 1.


