SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment of the Agreement, entered into this 24th day of October, 2018, by and between the CITY OF ALAMEDA, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and NUTE ENGINEERING, a California corporation whose address is 907 MISSION AVENUE, SAN RAFAEL, CALIFORNIA 94901, (hereinafter referred to as "Consultant"), in reference to the following:

RECITALS:

- A. City is a municipal corporation duly organized and validly existing under the laws of the State of California with the power to carry on its business as it is now being conducted under the statutes of the State of California and the Charter of the City.
- B. Various City projects require engineering professional services. The City issued a Request for Proposal for services in this contract scope and selected the firm that best meets the City's needs. This is the Second Amendment.
- C. On July 20, 2016 an agreement was entered into by and between City and Consultant (hereinafter "Agreement"). The compensation for the Agreement was \$333,069.
- D. On July 1, 2017 an agreement was entered into by and between City and Consultant (hereinafter "First Amendment"). The term of the First Amendment was modified to terminate on June 30, 2018.
- E. This is the Second Amendment of four to the Cyclic Sewer Rehabilitation Project, Phase 13 contract and is called Cyclic Sewer Rehabilitation Project, Phase 16.
- F. Consultant is specially trained, experienced, and competent to perform the special service which will be required by this Agreement.
- G. Consultant possesses the skill, experience, ability, background, certification, and knowledge to provide the services described in this Agreement on the terms and conditions described herein.
- H. City and Consultant desire to enter into a second amendment to agreement for engineering design services for the rehabilitation of approximately 2.7 miles of sewer main and associated manholes, and lower laterals, upon the terms and conditions herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the undersigned parties as follows:

1. Paragraph 1, <u>TERM</u>, of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"The term of this Agreement shall commence on the 20th day of July 2017 and shall terminate on the 30th day of September 2019, unless terminated earlier as set forth herein."

2. Paragraph 2, <u>SERVICES TO BE PERFORMED</u>, of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"Consultant agrees to perform all necessary work at its own cost and expense, to furnish all labor, tools, equipment, materials, except as otherwise specified, and to do all necessary work included in Exhibit A as requested. The Consultant acknowledges that the work plan included in Exhibit A is tentative and does not commit the City to request Consultant to perform all tasks included therein."

3. Paragraph 3, <u>COMPENSATION TO CONSULTANT</u>, Paragraph 1 and Paragraph 4 of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"Contractor shall be compensated for services performed pursuant to this Second Amendment to Agreement in the amount set forth in Exhibit "A" which is attached hereto an incorporated herein by reference. Payment shall be made by checks drawn on the treasury of the City, to be taken from CIP 99502602."

"Payment will be made by the City in the following manner: On the first day of each month, Consultant shall submit a written estimate of the total amount of work done the previous month. Payment will be for time and direct costs and are not to exceed budget. Pricing and accounting of charges to be according to the fee schedule in Exhibit "B" unless mutually agreed upon in writing. Extra work must be approved in writing by City prior to performance and shall be paid on a Time and Material basis using Exhibit "B" schedule."

"Total compensation for work under this Second Amendment shall not exceed \$394,390. Total compensation for work under this Agreement shall not exceed \$727,459."

4. Except as expressly modified herein, all other terms and covenants set forth in the Agreement shall remain the same and shall be in full force and effect.

Alameda Cyclic 16 Sewer Rehabilitation Project

Dear Ms. Smith:

Nute Engineering is pleased to submit this proposal for a Contract Amendment to provide engineering design services and construction services for the Alameda Cyclic 16 Sewer Rehabilitation Project. Our review of the sewer pipes (Attachment C) selected for 2018-19 shows that the project consists of the following:

13,279 linear feet of sewers in roadways (6"-8" diameter)
2,013 linear feet of easement/off-roadway sewers (6"-15" diameter)
15,292 LINEAR FEET TOTAL SEWER REPLACEMENT

It is understood that the Cyclic 16 project may be completed by McGuire and Hester, Inc., whom have been awarded the Cyclic 15 Construction Contract, through an optional Contract Amendment, or will be awarded through a public bidding process.
