
Federal funds to assist low- and moderateincome persons by providing:

- Mental health services
- Safety and crime prevention

# Needs Process for FY 2020-21 & 2021-22

- Step 1: SSHRB hears public comment and prepares a Needs Statement to be included as a part of the NOFA/RFP for Social Services and the overall Annual Action Plan (November 21, 2019)
- Step 2: City Council hears public comment and adopts Needs Statement (January 7, 2020)
- **Step 3:** RFP released, based on priority needs (Tentatively January 13, 2020)
