What is CDBG?

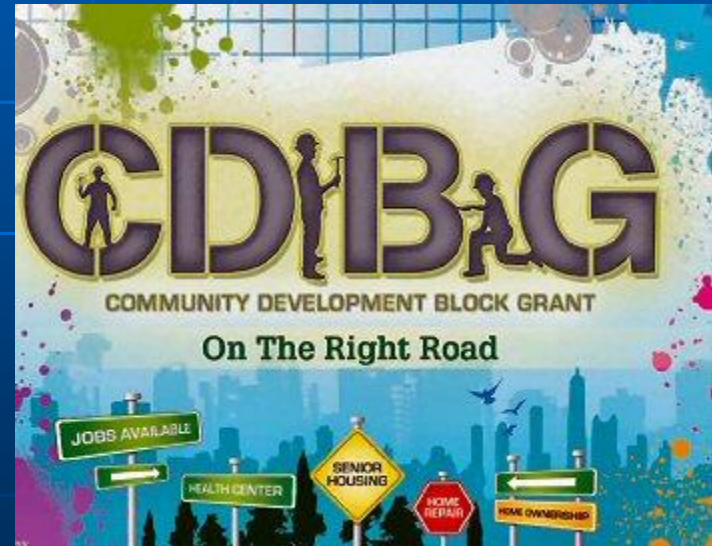
Federal funds to assist low- and moderate-income persons by providing:

- Decent Housing
- Suitable Living Environment
- Expanded Economic Opportunities

Needs Statement

Priorities for Non-Housing Public Services

Preserve Alameda's "Safety Net" services by directing public services funding to programs that provide:

- Tenant/Landlord mediation and counseling, tenant's rights and housing support
- Food security and food services
- Homeless services
- Mental health services
- Safety and crime prevention

Needs Process for FY 2020-21 & 2021-22

- **Step 1:** SSHRB hears public comment and prepares a Needs Statement to be included as a part of the NOFA/RFP for Social Services and the overall Annual Action Plan (November 21, 2019)
- **Step 2:** City Council hears public comment and adopts Needs Statement (January 7, 2020)
- **Step 3:** RFP released, based on priority needs (Tentatively January 13, 2020)
