AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND EXECUTE A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION DIVISION OF BOATING AND WATERWAYS AND THE CITY OF ALAMEDA BY AND THROUGH THE ALAMEDA POLICE DEPARTMENT

WHEREAS, the City of Alameda by and through the Police Department has been awarded a Surrendered and Abandoned Vessel Exchange (SAVE) grant allocation from the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways in the sum of \$75,000 for the purpose of abating derelict or abandoned recreational vessels from the marinas and waterways within its jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, in order to accept the SAVE grant allocation, the City Council must authorize the City Manager or her designee to enter into an agreement with the Division of Boating and Waterways; and

WHEREAS, a SAVE grant agreement has been prepared by the Division of Boating and Waterways which requires the signature of a City representative and a resolution by the City Council authorizing the signature.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Alameda that the City Manager, Eric Levitt, or his designee, Police Chief Paul Rolleri, is authorized to negotiate and execute the SAVE grant agreement between the City of Alameda by and through the Alameda Police Department and the State of California, Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways. * * * * * *
