AMENDING THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-20 POLICE GRANTS FUND
ESTIMATED REVENUE AND EXPENDITURES BUDGET IN THE
AMOUNT OF \$75,000 EACH FOR THE SURRENDERED AND
ABANDONED VESSEL EXCHANGE GRANT

WHEREAS, on June 18, 2019, the City Council adopt a budget representing the financial plan for conducting the affairs of the City of Alameda for the Fiscal Year beginning July 1, 2019 and ending June 30, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department applied and was awarded the Surrendered and Abandoned Vessel Exchange Grant from the Department of Parks and Recreation, Division of Boating and Waterways; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the grant is removing and disposing abandoned, surrendered, wrecked or dismantled vessels, or parts thereof, or any other partially submerged objects, which are likely to cause environmental degradation or pose a substantial hazard to navigation within the agency's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, staff is proposing that the Police Grants Fund estimated revenues and appropriations be increased by \$75,000 each; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the report and recommendations of the City Manager on the budget amendment and has determined that the budget amendment is both fair and appropriate; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has given this budget due consideration as to its projected revenues, anticipated expenditures and available fund balances.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Alameda that budget amendment for Fiscal Year 2019-20 Budget is approved for the Police Grants Fund by increasing estimated revenues and appropriations by \$75,000 each.
