Hi Eric,

There is no mistaking the uncertainty of the current economic landscape within the Downtown Alameda Business Association district. In order to support our members, the Association's Executive Committee respectfully requests that the standard BIA rate COLA increase be adjusted to 0% this year.

Additionally, we request that the required payment for business licenses is delayed until the Shelter in Place has been lifted, and our members have a chance to reopen and attempt to recover. At this point we would suggest a 90-day delay.

We appreciate the support of the City of Alameda as we navigate this new, uncharted territory.
