Hello to everyone on the PAC,

I don't know if it is too late to include another possible mural site for consideration, but since it is coming up for discussion again on Wednesday at the 6/15 PAC meeting, wanted to introduce you all to one of our neighbors and local businessman, Arthur Mercado.

Arthur spoke to me many years ago about being interested in having a mural on the ACR building on Blanding.
