Nicki,

As Yibin has stated, the September 15, 2020 City Council Agenda Item 5-K is not an item that impacts Boatworks. This item simply repeals the Alameda Point Development Impact Fee in its entirety. The item does not impose any new or additional fees. Boatworks's letter dated September 14, 2020, alleges that the City seeks to fund the proposed Regional Sports Complex through both the DIF and "a new fee system." This allegation is incorrect because the amended Master Fee schedule only removed the Alameda Point DIF and did not add any new fee. Further, Boatworks's projects will not be impacted by the repeal of the Alameda Point DIF.

We are open to further discussion if you feel that the Alameda Point DIF repeal somehow affects Boatworks, but hope that this clarification will allay any misunderstanding that Item 5-K implicates a violation of the Mitigation Fee Act.
