Background

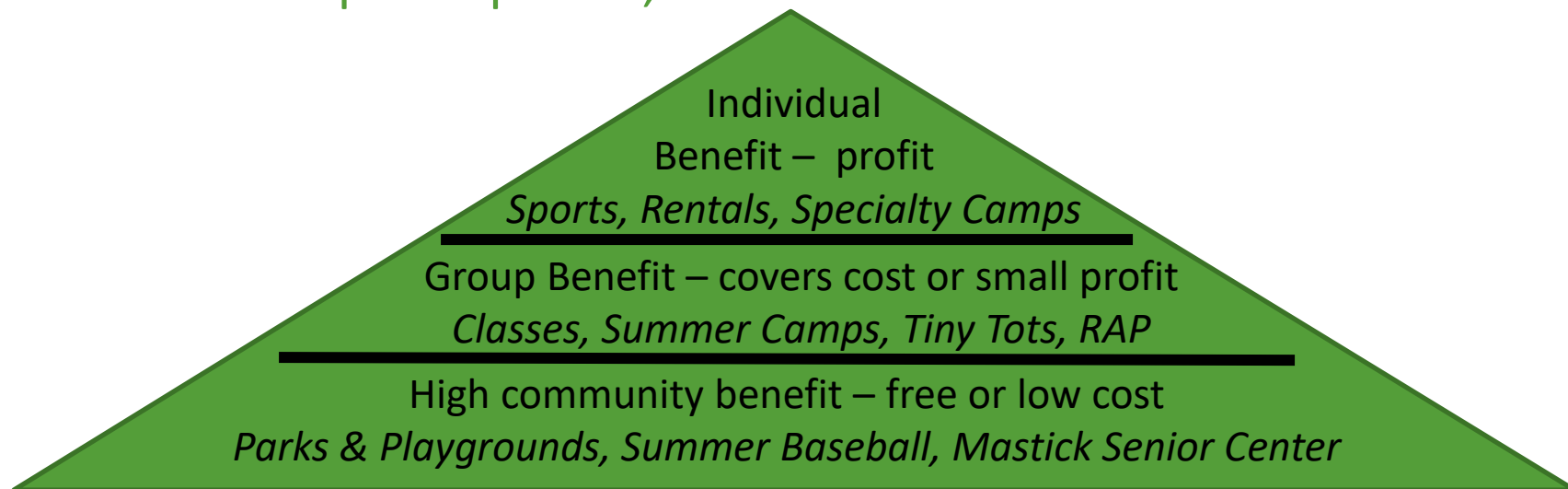


- High level challenges that impact fees:
 - Costs increase annually for staff (pay & benefits), contractual, and utilities.
- Balance of market demand and covering costs = incremental fee increases.
- Fees include direct costs (staff, facilities, supplies) plus indirect costs (administrative staff and supplies)
- Minimized fee increases this year due to complexities of the pandemic and in response to the economy and equity.
- Non-Alameda is at least 15% - 20% higher than resident/Alameda organizations.

ARPD Cost Recovery Model



- Goal to provide more effective cost recovery balanced with community benefit.
- Improved cost recovery primarily due to reduced expenses and increased participation, with minimal fee increases.

Open Gym Fee	Resident \$8/ session or 10 visit pass for \$72 Non-Res \$9/session or 10 visit pass for \$81
Youth Program Fees	2% increase – RAP, WOW, Day Camp, Teen Camp
