Facility	Uses
<b>The following parks, playgrounds and fields are used regularly for school recess, lunch and P.E.</b> <b>Some AUSD school blacktop areas are open to the public for community use after school hours</b> <b>City and AUSD each manage maintenance of their respective facilities</b>	
Ruby Bridges Elementary and Bayport Park	Park, school and recreation center were designed and constructed under Joint Use Agreement Students use the athletic fields in the park Community uses the blacktop on the school campus on weekends and summer
Otis Elementary and Krusi Park	Park and school were designed to work together Students use the athletic fields and playground daily Community uses the blacktop on the school campus
Franklin Elementary and Franklin Park	Students use the athletic fields, open grass and playground daily School is not open to the public
Bay Farm Elementary and Tillman Park	Students use the athletic fields, open grass and playground daily Community uses the blacktop on the school campus
Woodstock Park	Playground and fields used daily by charter school students (ACLC, NEA, AoA)
Longfellow Park	Playground and fields used intermittently by charter school students (ACLC, NEA, AoA)
Wood Middle School and Rittler Park	Students use the athletic fields daily
Edison Elementary	Community uses the playground and blacktop on the school campus
Earhart Elementary	Community uses the playground and blacktop on the school campus
<b>Swim Centers - Encinal and Emma Hood</b>	The swim centers at both high schools are utilized by the school teams and community use AUSD operates and maintains these pools and City schedules under a Joint Use Agreement
<b>City Gym, Athletic Fields and Tennis Courts</b> <i>The City drags and lines fields for AUSD</i> <i>AUSD teams have priority at city facilities</i>	Lincoln Park is primary field for AHS Varsity Baseball Washington Park is used by EHS Varsity Softball and JV Baseball Godfrey Park is used by AHS Junior Varsity Baseball Woodstock Park is used by EHS Junior Varsity Softball AEF provides middle school sports for District at Gym and City tennis courts
<b>All city parks used for school/class picnics every June</b>	
<b>Parks are provided upon request for events.</b>	Washington Park for Socials, Walk-a-thons, Krusi Park Stage, trainings at Rec Centers
<b>Corica Park Golf</b>	City provides free golf course use for high school teams This is written into the 50-year agreement with operator Greenway Golf
