School service

- Davis (AUSD) AUSD is committed to full opening in the fall and same bell times
 - But everything is contingent upon health guidelines
 - Add Susan Davis to distribution list
- Knox White Understands the bell time need
- Davis (AUSD) Understood the bell time needs, but school district was unable to make decisions in the timely manner

Ridership complaints and missed runs

- Peeples Are road calls higher than normal?
 - Llamas overall, numbers are good and reports are not extraordinary compared to normal

New developments

- Howard Terminal EIR Concern is the access and delay to the posey tube; need to keep buses moving;
 will send letter to AC staff
- Ortiz Where would funding come from for help with transit services to the ball park?
 - Thomas ask that the project fund supplemental transit service during Howard Terminal event days; we don't want people circling back to other crossings because it creates more VMT

- Hursh AC Transit also sent a letter
- Ortiz important for transit agencies to work with local jurisdictions on the transportation plan

- Park Street Looking for any transit travel time data on Park; interested in continuing parklets
- Knox White Trust that staff is working together
