SECOND AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT

This Second Amendment of the Agreement, entered into this _____ day of July 2021, by and between the CITY OF ALAMEDA, a municipal corporation (hereinafter "City") and CIVICORPS, a California Non-Profit Corporation, whose address is 101 MYRTLE STREET, OAKLAND, CALIFORNIA, 94607, (the "Provider"), in reference to the following:

RECITALS:

- A. On March 18, 2019, an agreement was entered into by and between City and Provider (hereinafter "Agreement") in the amount of \$33,600.
- B. On May 18, 2020, an agreement was entered into by and between City and Provider (hereinafter "First Amendment to Agreement") in the amount of \$33,600.
- C. City and Provider desire to modify the Agreement on the terms and conditions set forth herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the undersigned parties as follows:

1. Item No.1 **TERM** of the Agreement is modified to read as follows:

"The term of this Agreement shall retroactively commence on the 18th day of March 2019, and shall terminate on the 31st day of March 2024, unless terminated earlier as set forth herein."

- 2. Item No. 3, **COMPENSATION TO PROVIDER** paragraph b is modified to read as follows:
- "b. The total compensation for the work under this Second Amendment to Agreement is not to exceed \$33,600 for a contract total of \$168,000."

Under this method, each insurer's share is based on the ratio of its applicable limit of insurance to the total applicable limits of insurance of all insurers.
