I am writing to ask that item 7-A, McKay Ave. Design review be exempted from your call for review. The planning Board heard all those comments and approved the design review with certain conditions. The staff will be reporting back on our compliance with those conditions, and both the board and any members of the public wishing to do so will have the opportunity to again provide comment.

As you know, we are in the midst of an unprecedentd homeless crisis, and the Wellness Center is a critical response to that crisis. The program was recently awarded \$15 million from the State of California, and we are prepared to pull permits and begin work on the project. Every delay not only increases the cost of the project, but also results in more homeless dying on our streets. Thank you for consideration of our request .
