AMENDING THE SALARY SCHEDULE FOR THE ALAMEDA CITY EMPLOYEES ASSOCIATION (ACEA) AND THE ALAMEDA POLICE OFFICERS ASSOCIATION, NON-SWORN (PANS) TO MOVE THE PARKING ENFORCEMENT POSITIONS FROM PANS TO ACEA AND TO REASSIGN THE TWO POSITIONS FROM THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PUBLIC WORKS

WHEREAS, the City must actively manage its public parking and curb space to achieve City Council ("Council") adopted goals related to transportation; and

WHEREAS, an effective parking management program requires holistic planning and the ability to effectively allocate resources to improve or change the program; and

WHEREAS, a reorganization of the City's Parking Management Program is being recommended. This reorganization includes moving the Parking Management Program from the Police Department to the Public Works Department; and

WHEREAS, to ensure the reorganized Parking Management Program can successfully operate it is recommended to move the two parking technician positions (Lead Parking Technician and Parking Technician) from the Police Department to the Public Works Department (Fund 265) and to move the positions from the PANS Labor Association to the ACEA Labor Association.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Alameda amend the salary schedule for the PANs and ACEA labor association to move the Lead Parking Technician and the Parking Technician positions from PANS to ACEA and transfer the positions from the Police Department to Public Works fund 265.
