**Whereas**, in June 2020, during the COVID-19 pandemic, Rick was appointed Interim Fire Chief. In this capacity, and utilizing his strong background in disaster preparedness, Rick helped establish the City's Emergency Operations Center to provide a comprehensive response to the pandemic; and

**Whereas**, Rick also served the Alameda community as Chair of the Alameda Disaster Council, a member of the Alameda Red Cross Volunteers Disaster Task Force, and a member of various community preparedness advisory boards, and;

**Whereas**, as he celebrates his retirement, the City of Alameda heartily thanks Rick for his 38 ½ years of service to this city, his steadfast leadership as Interim Fire Chief, and as a respected, valued, and enjoyable member of Team Alameda.
